City Utility Payments

City utility payments are due by the 15th of every month. There is a grey drop box installed in front of the Professional Building at 308 Main St E for your convenience. You can also view your utility bill online. It is a safe, secure service that encrypts the utility bill until you enter your user name and password. As an added feature, you can opt to pay your bill online with a credit/debit card or by echeck. There is a small service fee; this service fee in most cases would be less than a late fee you could incur if your payment was delayed. To register to view and/or pay your bill online go to www.ub-pay.com and use Municipal Code: HendrumMN550. Automatic payments taken directly from you checking or savings account is another way to pay. Pick up an application from the city clerk's office or find a copy to print from the city website www.hendrummn.com.
